Pendant Lamp 1609-3 "Diamond Cut"

The Black-Gold Family

With this pendant lamp one brings the splendour of the black-gold Empire into small chambers, hallways or staircases. By combining the flourish black-gold Empire design on the surrounding belt with a simple cut crystal bowl we created a splendid but still small lamp for many applications.

The belt is ornamented with the typical Empire décor in cast and gilded brass and further highlighted with exquisite ornaments on the rim. Also the chain links are richly ornamented and gilded.

The bowl is executed in the exquisite diamond cut technique which reflects the light best. In it sit the light bulbs, hidden from direct sight.
